

# Re-engaging our Faith

August 15, we will celebrate two services in person and one service online going forward each Sunday morning! Services will be at 9:30 and 11:00 am, with a 10:00 am on-line service. It will re-engage our connection time of fellowship around coffee or bottled water between the services.

Some classes will return to in-person at 9:30 and others at 11:00 – and masks will be optional but available if you are unvaccinated for your protection. But the main thing is: we will gather in Jesus' name. We will worship our Lord God and Savior Jesus with a new depth. We will feel tremendous joy in our hearts and give thanks and praise to God.

Not everything will be the same as it was before COVID-19, because we are not the same and the world is not the same. But what is the same – Jesus called us to gather in the church he would build upon the rock. In Acts 20:28, Peter declares, "Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood."

For those who can gather in-person, the time has come when we are encouraged to move from pajamas and the couch - to experience in-person baptisms, professions of faith, partake together in Holy Communion, witness a child learning at children's time, hear a fellow faith traveler share a burden, sit in a space with other believer's, pray silently together, and speak a creed collectively or affirmation of faith.

Some will not be able to gather in-person for health reasons. Some will not be able to gather because they have become homebound or have moved. Some pews in our worship space will be missing the familiar faces of those who have gone on to life eternal during the last seventeen months. Those unable to be in-person will be able to gather with this community of faith in the sacred time of on-line worship. They will be encouraged and challenged in their faith by Pastor Erin, our on-line pastor and Sarah Henson, our Director of Student Ministries.


Sunday, August 1st will be Youth Sunday at our 10 am service. Anyone who is participating can arrive at the church at 9:45 am.

# The 'Who' and 'Why' of How our Music Is Chosen for Worship

We are often asked: "Why did you chose that song?", "Who chose that hymn?" "Why do we never sing my favorite hymn/song?"

Worship crafting is an art. New World has a team of people who craft all of our worship services. This team is Pastor Leslie, Pastor Erin, Steven Couch, Kathy



Alexander, Sarah Henson, Josh Bender and Sarah Duer. The thematic series and scriptures are chosen at least six months in advance by Pastor Leslie. The team takes each series and works together discussing the theme of each series and the theme of each week within that series. The take-away message of each week is communicated and from there Steven Couch and Sarah Duer begin choosing music. We pour through different website resources comparing them to our current repertoire of songs and hymns. We then, look back through the calendar and see when those songs or hymns were used last in worship. Particular attention is given to the tempo, spirit, key, resources needed, placement and familiarity of each song. Our hope is always that each song points to the central theme of the day. We want each word that is sung to guide the congregation toward that theme and to set that theme deep within each heart.

Therefore, every favorite hymn or song may not be thematically appropriate every year. It is our hope that the congregation will grow to love many different types of songs and hymns. We wish to worship and communicate through all the different types of music available to us with our current resources. We pray that congregants see the connections between the music and the sermon each week and that those lyrics stay within all our hearts throughout the week as a reminder of the sermon.
