This time of year, we kick off our fall ministries and new opportunities with great excitement. We are still planning, but dates for some of our ministries to start-up are temporarily on hold due to COVID spikes.

#### **New World Food Pantry Update**

In the Spring of 2020, a global pandemic sent school children to remote learning and caused many in our community to lose income. Part of this crisis was realizing that many of the most vulnerable local students and their families depended on the local schools in order to get enough food to eat. In May of



2020, New World partnered with Rush Creek Church and Arlington ISD to begin delivering weekly groceries and snack bags to families in need throughout Arlington ISD.

Let's celebrate! In the past 61 weeks, New World volunteers have packed and delivered over **1,280 bags of groceries** for families, and over **4,200 snack bags** for children. Dozens of church members have volunteered and donated, and we delivered more than **\$38,500** worth of food during that time! What a blessing to our neighbors!

**And Now, A New Opportunity:** As students return to in-person learning, we are continuing the ministry of feeding our neighbors but in a new way. As the new school year begins, we are partnering with **Jones Academy of Fine Arts and Dual Language** in North Arlington to provide weekly snack bags for students. Jones Academy has over 500 students, 65% of which are low income. It's hard for hungry students to learn. The school is so excited that New World will be able to help their students - and our vision is that the partnership will only grow over time!

With our help, students will be able to get nutritious snacks. You can help by stocking our food pantry with items such as:

beef sticks, mac and cheese cups, applesauce cups, ramen noodles, oatmeal, Vienna sausage, Nutrigrain bars, individual cereal boxes, cheese crackers, juice boxes (100% juice only), small bottles of water, tuna packets, Chef Boyardee cups

- Advent Candle wreath stand with candles (Steven has one selected)

### **GIVING "QR CODE"**

The Offering is a sacred moment in the life of the worship service. There are many sacred moments, yet the offering invites us to respond to the love God has for us and show our generosity by asking *"Lord, what do you want to do through me?"* 

In today's culture, many people seldom carry cash and 30% of our congregation participate regularly through online giving. To participate in online giving visit our website at **nwumc.org** and click on

the Give tab. To set up an automatic draft (which 100% of your donation goes to the church), call the church office and Heather can help you set that up. You can choose to have your donation drafted weekly, biweekly or monthly.

We pass the plates in both services as an act of offering, and at the Traditional service return the offering plates to the altar and sing the Doxology in praising God "from whom all blessings flow". People who have no cash and don't give online have commented they feel bad not putting something in the plate.

So, we have placed a "QR Code" sign on the two credenzas on each side of the center doors at the back wall of the sanctuary. This will allow you to access with your phone and takes you to the giving site to respond with an offering. We want to give people ease and availability to show their generosity in meaningful ways that impact the community around us.
